Rajasthan SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS INDEX -2022 (Ver.-3.0)



Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

With the rapid change in environment due to global warming and increasing inequality across the world, it has been recognized that growth is not enough to ensure the welfare of people. Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) is a universal agenda to all countries. Sustainable Development Goals are a collection of 17 global goals which were developed after intensive public consultation and engagement with national government, civil societies and stakeholders around the world. These 17 Goals include areas such as climate change, economic inequality, innovation, sustainable consumption, peace and justice, among other priorities. The 17 SDGs comprise of 169 associated targets, which are interconnected in nature. The targets for each goal are accompanied with indicators that focus on measurable outcomes. Each target has defined monitoring indicators to measure progress towards reaching the target.

SDG India Index

With the objective of measuring the progress of SDGs and develop competitiveness among States and UTs, NITI Aayog has released three versions of SDG India Index till now. Based on the results of the SDG India Index, States and Union Territories (UTs) have been classified into 4 categories: Achiever, Front runner, Performer and Aspirant, where the 'Achiever' category represents the highest rank and the 'Aspirant' category represents the lowest rank.

SDG India Index 1.0: The first version of the Index i.e. SDG India Index Baseline Report, 2018 (SDG India Index 1.0) was released in December, 2018. The Index tracks the progress of all the States and UTs on a set of 62 indicators covering 13 SDGs (leaving out Goals 12, 13, 14 and 17, mainly because of paucity of data). As per the report, Rajasthan has been ranked as 'Performer' with 59 composite score in SDG India Index 1.0. The all India score stood at 57.

SDG India Index 2.0: It is the second version of the Index which builds upon its first version. It was launched in December, 2019. The Index has been constructed using 100 indicators that covers 54 targets across 16 goals barring Goal 17 due to the fact that the data for SDG 17 are not available. On the lines of the first version of the SDG India Index, States and UTs have been classified into 4 categories i.e. Achiever, Front runner, Performer and Aspirant in SDG India Index 2.0. As per the report, Rajasthan has been ranked as 'Performer' on Composite SDG India Index 2.0 with the Index Score of 57 whereas all India score stood at 60.

SDG India Index 3.0: SDG India Index 3.0 launched in June, 2021 in which composite score for India improved to 66 in 2020-21 of 60 in 2019-20, indicating that the country overall has progressed forward in its journey towards achieving the SDGs. Rajasthan improved its overall SDG score from 57 in 2019-20 to 60 in 2020-21, albeit retaining its position in the Performer category. 16 SDGs that were quantitatively assessed between 2019-2020 and 2020-21, Rajasthan shows maximum improvement in Goal 7 (Affordable and Clean Energy), achieving 100 score.

Rajasthan SDGs Index

The SDG Index of Rajasthan aims to measure the performance of districts on the SDG's. Additionally, SDG Index can be broken down into goal level score in order to help understand what goals have been achieved and where more effort is needed. NITI Aayog's Methodology was used in computing these index and set of indicators chosen as per availability of district wise data in the state. Districts have been also classified into 4 categories: Achiever, Front runner, Performer and Aspirant, where the 'Achiever' category represents the highest rank and the 'Aspirant' category represents the lowest rank.

Rajasthan SDGs Index 1.0:

The SDG Index has been developed using 31 indicators across 12 goals. The data is retrieved from publicly available sources for these identified indicators. These data were aggregated to develop individual SDG score for each district in Rajasthan, which is then used to develop the Sustainable development goals index for Rajasthan. For each goal, the SDG score ranges between 0 and 100, where 0 being the worst among the group and 100 signifying that all the targets for that goal/all goals have been achieved. District wise Status of composite scores and ranks of Rajasthan SDG Index 1.0 and 2.0 is available at annexure I.

Rajasthan SDGs Index 2.0:

The SDG Index has been developed using 55 indicators across 13 goals. The data is retrieved from publicly available sources for these identified indicators. These data has been aggregated to develop individual SDG score for each district in Rajasthan, which is then used to develop the Sustainable development goals index for Rajasthan. For each goal, the SDG score ranges between 0 and 100, where 0 being the worst among the group and 100 signifying that all the targets for that goal/all goals have been achieved.

Rajasthan SDGs Index 3.0:

This Rajasthan SDG Index has been calculated on 75 indicators covering 14 goals. Data of these indicators is collected from various departmental information/Data and publicly available sources. These data has been aggregated to calculate individual SDG score for each district in Rajasthan, which is then used to develop the C o m p o s i t e Sustainable development goals Index for Rajasthan. For each goal, the SDG score ranges between 0 and 100, where 0 being the worst among the group and 100 signifying that all the targets for that goal/all goals have been achieved. District wise Rajasthan SDG Index 3.0 score and ranks are given in the table 1. District wise Status of scores and ranks of Rajasthan SDG Index 1.0, 2.0 and 3.0 are given at Annexure-1.

Districts have been classified into 4 categories: Achiever, Front runner, Performer and Aspirant, where the 'Achiever' category represents the highest rank and the 'Aspirant' category represents the lowest rank. Details are given in the table 2.

Methodology

The methodology used to calculate SDG Index is as follows:

- Indicator selection and data collection:** Based on the data availability, 75 indicators are selected for developing the Sustainable Development Goals Rajasthan Index. Data collected on these indicators from various government departments, Publications, Reports, Portals/ Dashboard of Government of Rajasthan and India. The list of these indicators is given in table 3.

2. **Target Setting:** Use the targets set for each indicator in calculating the Sustainable Development Goals Index on the lines of NITI Aayog. Basically, target has been decided as laid down points:
 - As per SDG India Index 3.0
 - As per SDG targets decided by GoI/NITI Aayog
 - Target decided by United Nations Agencies
 - Average of Best 3 Performance Districts
 - Best performance District Value

The details on the targets used are presented at **Annexure – II.**

3. **Normalization:** Since the indicators used in the construction of index have different units of measurement, the units are normalized in order to be able to compare different districts based on a variety of indicators. Normalisation transforms all data into dimensionless numbers. Normalization of the indicators is done using the formula used by NITI Aayog in the calculation of SDG India Index. For each indicator the normalised values range from 0 to 100. An indicator value of 100 means that the district has achieved the target in terms of that indicator. If a district scores more than 100 on an indicator i.e. it is doing better than the target set, then its value is capped at 100 the normalised. Indicator and district wise normalized capped score are presented at **Annexure – III.**

For positive indicators the normalised value of an indicator is calculated as follows:

$$Z = \frac{x - \min(x)}{T(x) - \min(x)} \times 100$$

Where:

- Z is the normalised score for the indicator
- x is the indicator value in raw data
- $\min(x)$ is the minimum observed value of the indicator in the dataset
- T(x) is the target value of the indicator

For negative indicators the normalised value of an indicator is calculated as follows:

$$Z = [1 - \frac{x - T(x)}{\max(x) - T(x)}] \times 100$$

Where:

- Z is the normalised score for the indicator
- x is the indicator value in raw data
- $\max(x)$ is the maximum observed value of the indicator in the dataset
- T(x) is the target value of the indicator

4. **Weighting:** Each indicator is assigned a weight, indicating the importance it has in influencing SDGs. Here, each indicator has been assigned equal weight. This is based on the assumption that each indicator has equal value for sustainable development.
5. **Calculating SDI score for each goal:** For each goal, the index value is calculated for each district by taking the arithmetic mean of the normalized values of all the indicators within a goal. The values for SDG score range in between 0 to 100 with 0 being the worst performer in the group and 100 being the achiever of the target. The details on goal wise scores for each district is presented at **Annexure – IV**.
6. **Calculating SDG Index score for a district:** Each goal is assigned an equal weight in calculating the SDI score for the district. For each goal, the SDG score range in between 0 to 100 with 0 being the worst among the group and 100 meaning that all the targets under that goal have been achieved. The list of goal wise indicators used in the preparation of SDI is already given in Table No. 3. The goal wise top 3 and bottom 3 districts are presented at **Annexure – V**.

Limitations of the Index

While Rajasthan SDG Index 3.0 is a useful instrument to judge the progress of the Districts in adopting and implementing the SDG agenda, this Index have the following limitations:

- The Index does not measure indicators of all SDGs owing to the unavailability of suitable data at the District level.
- The indicator set for Rajasthan SDG Index 3.0 is larger (75 indicators) compared to Rajasthan SDG Index 1.0 (31 indicators), and 2.0 (55 Indicators), therefore these indices are strictly not Comparable. Further, given the comprehensiveness of the agenda, benchmarks will undergo continual change to meet the aspirations of SDGs.
